portant that as believers we learn to live by the victory of our Lord. When He was on earth, He told the people in His day that the words that He speaks, they are spirit as they are life (See John 6:63). That means that the most powerful weapon, or the most powerful treasure that Jesus had were His words, and how powerfully blessed they were.

In fact, when you read other prophetic declarations and utterances concerning the Lord, like as you read in Isaiah chapter 11 verse 4, one of the things that was prophesied of the Lord Jesus Christ even before His birth was that he would judge the wicked one with the rod of His mouth and the breath of His lips. So it indicates to us that long ago before His birth there's been an orchestration that the weapon through which the Lord is going to use to overcome this world and to overcome the lawless one, the wicked enemy, is through the breath of His mouth and the rod of His mouth.

In fact, when you read an account concerning when he was being captured by the soldiers on the night before His crucifixion, you see very clearly that it states that when they asked of who among them was the Lord at the time when the disciples had gathered, Jesus simply answered, 'I am He'; And those words alone caused the soldiers to stagger back and fall. So the soldiers fell because he simply said the words, 'I am He'. (John 18:6)

Finally, at the end of the age when all the armies of this world have gathered against Israel, the Bible says that out of the clouds suddenly the Son of God, Jesus Christ, along with his hosts like us, will start descending down out of the clouds with Him. And they will turn their weapons against the Lord and His hosts, but the Bible says that He will destroy the antichrist and the armies of this world with the two-edged sword that comes out of his mouth. It's too powerful to think that the words of the Lord Jesus Christ can cut through more than a sword. Like we are told in Hebrews chapter 4 and 12; the word of God being sharper than any two-edged sword, the word of God itself is a two-edged sword. We'll share more on this reality tomorrow.
